We offer discounted camper fees to families, thanks to the generosity of our donors. These pricing tiers are based on household income and do not reflect the true cost of camp sessions. No matter which pricing tier you choose, the experience, amenities and level of care is the same value of \$3,700 per session.

Funding Your Camp Experience

Many funding opportunities exist to help pay for your camper's experience at Camp Aldersgate in addition to the discounted camp fees.

Scholarships

Camp Aldersgate is able to provide additional financial assistance through a limited number of scholarships. If you are interested in applying for a scholarship, please email programs@campaldersgate.net to begin your application process.

Agency Funding

Some agencies offer funding for individuals with specific medical conditions to attend Camp Aldersgate. Check out your local health partners to see what options may exist. Participants attending Muscular Dystrophy Camp or Spinal Disorders Camp must be registered with the [Muscular Dystrophy Association](#) or [Arkansas Spinal Cord Commission](#) to qualify for agency funding.

Sibling Discount

Families may be eligible for a 20% discount* on each additional camper's fee. For more information regarding the sibling discount, please contact the Camp Aldersgate office. **Valid for Kota Camps & Weekend Camps only. Siblings must attend the same session to qualify for sibling discount.*

Waiver/PASSE

If your camper has an existing Waiver or PASSE, you may be able to use funds to help pay for your camp session. If you do not know if you have Waiver or PASSE, or are interested in applying, visit passe.arkansas.gov or call 1-833-402-0672.

Children with Chronic Health Conditions (CHC) program

If your camper does not qualify for Waiver or PASSE, has a physical disability, and meets other requirements by the DHS, you might be eligible for CHC funding. To learn more about this program, visit humanservices.arkansas.gov.
