



2026 Camper Fees

Thanks to the generosity of our donors, we can offer discounted camper fees to make camp more affordable for families. Applicants can choose the tier price that best fits what they can pay. If a camper is not eligible for PASSE or health agency funding, the family will pay their selected tier price. Scholarships are available for those who need additional assistance.

The **Tier Prices** are subsidized rates to help make camp accessible to families. Tier 1 is the most subsidized rate, and Tier 3 covers many camp expenses but still reflects a discount to the program fees.

The **Core Cost** covers more of the program's direct expenses than our discounted tiered rates. This is also the rate that is billed to Waiver and PASSE.

The **True Cost** reflects the full, actual cost of delivering an exceptional camp experience, including program, staffing, and facility expenses. Families who are able may choose this rate to help support the camp's mission and ensure its sustainability for future campers.

No matter what tier you choose, the amenities, activities, and camp experience are the same.

Funding Your Camp Experience

Many funding opportunities exist to help pay for your camper's experience at Camp Aldersgate in addition to the discounted camp fees.

Agency Funding

Some agencies offer funding for individuals with specific medical conditions to attend Camp Aldersgate. Check out your local health partners to see what options may exist. Participants attending Muscular Dystrophy Camp or Spinal Disorders Camp must be registered with the [Muscular Dystrophy Association](#) or [Arkansas Spinal Cord Commission](#) to qualify for agency funding. Arkansas Children's funds the Audiology AIM-HI Camp for qualifying participants.

Waiver/PASSE

If your camper has an existing Waiver or PASSE, you may be able to use funds to pay for your camp session. If you do not know if you have Waiver or PASSE, or are interested in applying, visit passe.arkansas.gov or call 1-833-402-0672.

Children's Special Services (CSS) Program

If your camper does not qualify for Waiver or PASSE, has a physical disability or chronic health condition, and meets other requirements by the DHS, you may be eligible for CSS funding. To learn more about this program, visit humanservices.arkansas.gov.
